### Environmental grants - report on 2021/22 and new application for this year

The steering group submitted its report on our work in 2021/22, reporting Heights Care's activities completed on time and within budget. The report set out the work of the Landcare members weeding, planting indigenous species and stabilising dead timber. It also reported on the seminar.

We have submitted a similar grant for the coming year and hope to receive good news on its outcome around the end of July.
